The vaccination process has now started in Suffolk. The NHS will contact you with the time, date and location of your vaccination appointment. How much difference will it make to our lives? Firstly it will be a great relief to have some protection, but be careful - it takes 30 days and two jabs to achieve this. After this be aware that you may still catch a mild form of Covid, and you could possibly unknowingly spread it too. So there will be no relaxation of mask wearing and social distancing rules for those who have been vaccinated any differently from anybody else.
