

FRAMLINGHAM NEW PARKING METERS

WHERE WE ARE NOW - 26.11.20

Fore Street car park: is operating normally with the new pay and display regulations in place.

The Elms car park: will shortly be operating the same system. In the meantime parking here is free subject to the advertised time restrictions.

Market Hill parking: implementation of the new regulations in Market Hill has been suspended temporarily pending the signing of a legal agreement between East Suffolk Council and Framlingham Town Council which formally identifies which parking spaces are included in the scheme. Until then, parking here is free subject to the advertised time restrictions.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Pay for parking by registering your numberplate directly into the machine; via the RingGo app; or by telephone.

You can then select the 30 minute free parking option. This free period is currently only available once a day for each vehicle in all car parks. We are seeking to have this changed to twice a day to make it easier for parents dropping off and collecting pupils for the primary school.
